Slide 8: <u>Lessons learned?</u> This slide should include the main things that you learned about a career in this Pathway. What impressed you and what did not impress you?

Slide 9: <u>Personal insight into the value of this experience.</u> Reference what this experience meant to you and what you gained from it.

Slide 10: <u>Is this the Career Path you plan to pursue?</u> It is just as important to know what you do not what to do for a career as it is to know what you do want to do for a career. Indicate on this slide if you plan to pursue a career within the path of the Career Cord that you will be receiving at graduation. Please give examples of why or why not.
